





Data collection for t₁ completed

Data collection for t₂ started (cohorte 1 complete; cohorte 2 starting fall 2018).

Population t_1 : N= 5'198

Sample t₁: N= 3'104




Abbildung 2: Erwartungen an den zukünftigen Beruf (Erstbefragung 2017, N= 972-979)





Abbildung 5: Beschwerden im letzten Studienjahr (Erstbefragung 2017, N= 997-1007)
